

## Winter Waterfowl of RI Syllabus

For the first class of Winter Waterfowl of RI, Bill Carpenter and I show a Powerpoint about the species and characteristics of all of the ducks we might see in our area. We point out features and similarities of each duck as we go along. We end the first class with a 30 minute film that Bill Carpenter and I did showing waterfowl at various locations around the state.
