Course Description: Join us as we explore the battles that women gave fought to gain cultural equity. Women in the visual arts have struggled to surmount hurdles in painting, sculpture, photography and installation. In the growing New York scene, their presence was felt more strongly in the 1940's. What hurdles did they face and how did each one prevail? Today women are closer to parity with men in the visual arts, but are they really equal? Let's explore what contemporary women painters and photographers are saying in their work and why people are listening now.

Class Meeting Format: Class members will give weekly presentations, as will the coordinators on occasion, and who will also lead discussions. Twenty-five minutes per presentation will allow the presenter to ask the group some thoughtful questions and to allow us some time for discussion.
